## **Mission Statement**

The REBEL Program aims to give students the power to shape their college experience. ## **Program Structure and Curriculum**

REBEL participants will take part in an event management training session under the guidance of the Student Life Department, and more specifically, the Activities Coordinator. Following the training session, bi-weekly meetings will be held and conducted similar to other student clubs and organizations. In addition to meetings, REBEL participants will be responsible for the planning, execution and evaluation of all Student Life Events. A Student Life appointed work study will serve as the acting President under the direction of the Activities Coordinator.

## **Program Commitment**

***You must attend the event training session and 75% of all meetings and events!*** Every student on campus is extremely busy, before applying it is critical that you decide now if you can make this commitment. Meetings will be held on every other Wednesday, from 11:30am-12:30pm (roughly 8 meetings per semester). If you have a conflict at that time, exceptions can be made. Events are held on various days and times to ensure participants the opportunity to attend (roughly 16 total events).

***You must have the desire to take an active role in campus activities!*** This is a very prestigious leadership program, which will allow you to develop leadership skills in a hands-on environment. Participants will have the ability to positively impact the Oklahoma State University-Okmulgee campus.
